Adverse weather plan

In the event of adverse weather, plans will be put into place to ensure all horses can still reach their water and forage.

In the Summer, we will provide adequate shelter for all horses in the event of extreme heat. All horses will have 24/7 access to water, and will be fetched in from the field for adequate checks and hosing off if the weather is very hot.

Fly masks, sun cream and fly rugs are provided in summer for all horses.

In winter, in the event of snow, all paths and access to the fields are gritted and salted so that their turn out regime can stay as normal as possible, and they still have access to their fields.

In the event of snow, ad lib hay will be provided in all fields where grass cannot be reached due to the snow. All horses will wear the appropriate rugs depending on factors such as their condition and whether or not they require a rug. Ice on water troughs are broken twice daily and checked thoroughly.

In the event of torrential rain, all horses will come in or be provided with adequate shelter, and rugs. In usual cases, all horses would come in out of the rain anyway.

Weather forecasts are checked twice daily, 365 days per year and plans are put into place for adequate horse care in any weather conditions.
